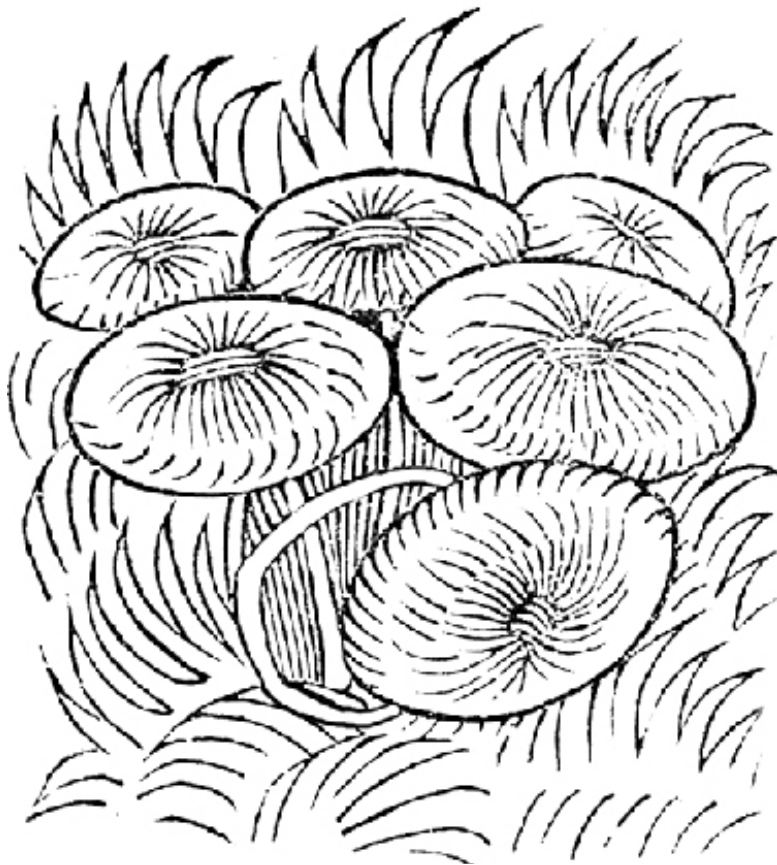

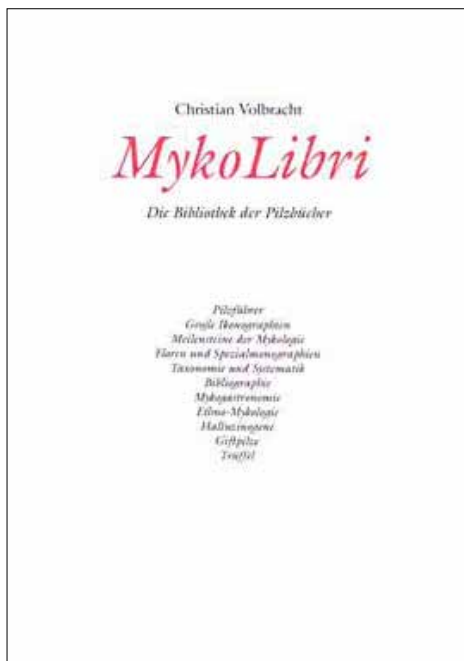

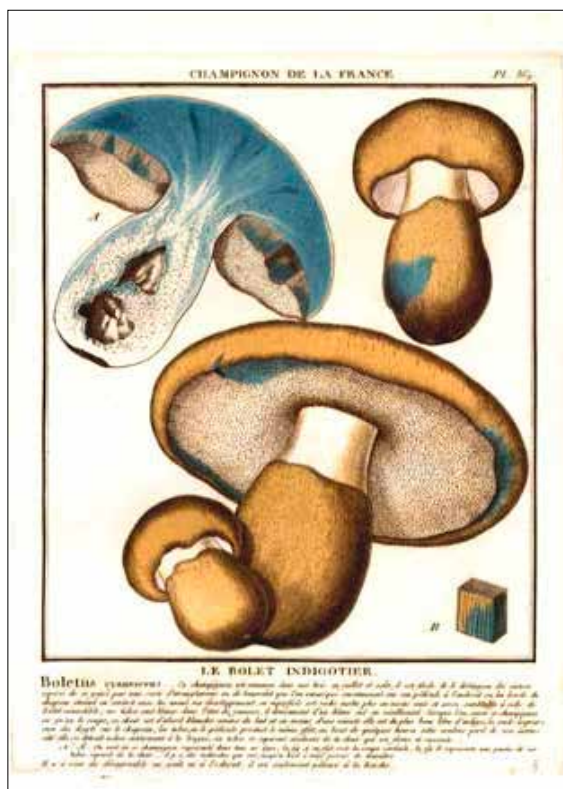

Pierre Bulliard was born in 1752 and became famous for this herbier with its important mycological part. The author suddenly died in 1793, when he had completed the printing of all the 602 plates of his Herbier, with the text for Plantes veneneuses and the most part of text for the champignons de la France. The botanist E. P. Ventenat completed the text, using Bulliards notes. Shortly after printing of the completed volume 2 in 1812, a fire destroyed most of the the stock.

The work is the first with colour printed plates of fungi. Bulliard developed his own printing method for coloured copper-engravings. He drew and engraved the plates and



mixed the inks. For printing, he superimposed three tint plates, each with the individual tones necessary to print separately the blue, red and yellow of each image. All the plates have tiny holes in the corners to fix paper with needles for sequential printing.

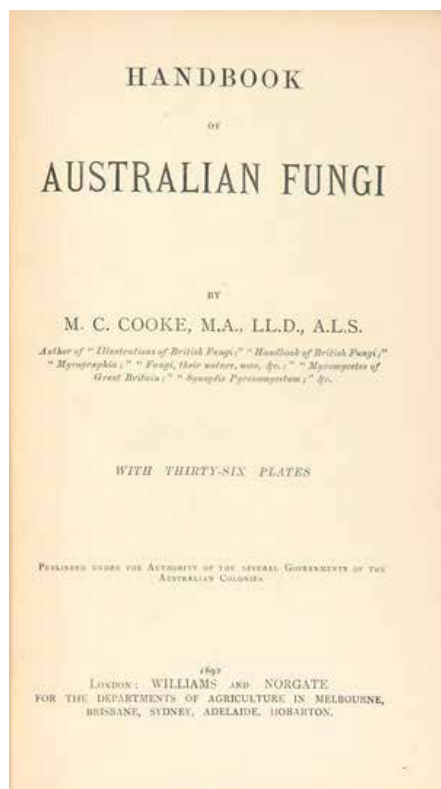

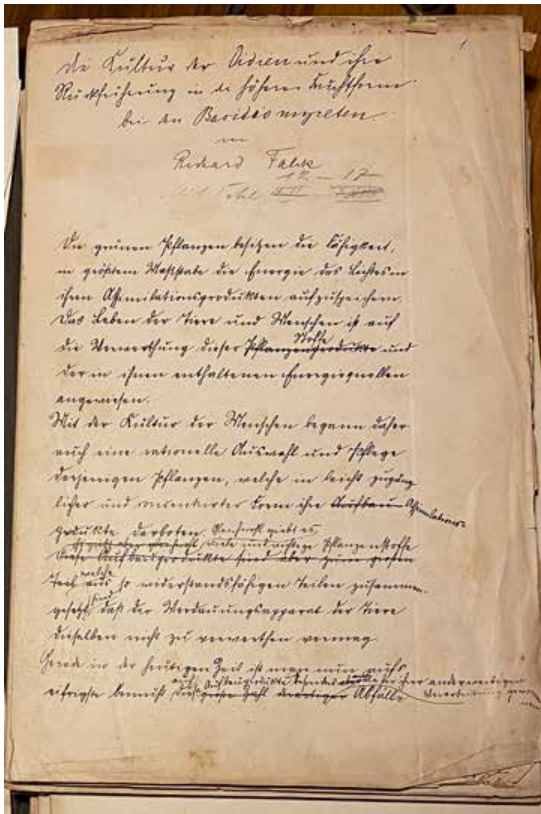

The Jewish scientist worked at the forest academy in Hannoversch Münden. Many years before Fleming he was the first to discover and describe an antibiotic obtained from *Sparassis crispa*, the fungicide Sparassol, but he did not pursue the discovery any further. In 1933, he fled from the Nazis to Jerusalem, then to Poland and Russia. He finally moved with his extensive mycological library to USA and died in 1955 in Atlanta.

The manuscripts and notes allow a deep insight into Falck's research. Of special interest is the handwritten text of the recommendation for the acceptance of the dissertation by the mycologist Oscar Brefeld, his PhD supervisor. It contains numerous corrections to the text, so it seems reasonable to conclude that Falck could have written the text for the recommendation himself. Brefeld became increasingly blind in 1902.
